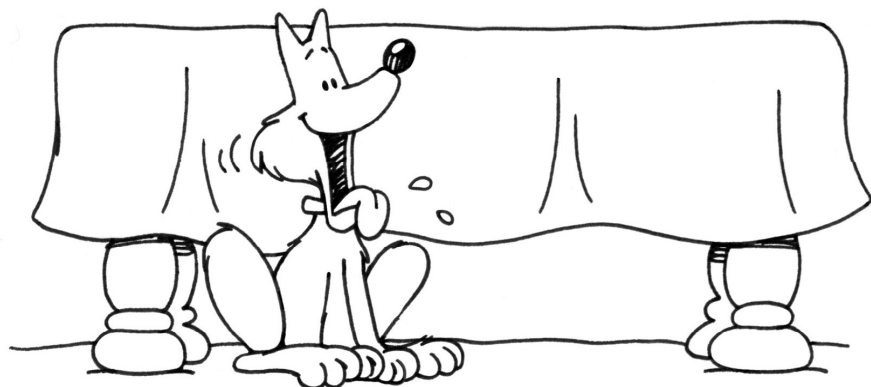




## SOMETHING to DRAW

Draw some of the food he might have had on the table.

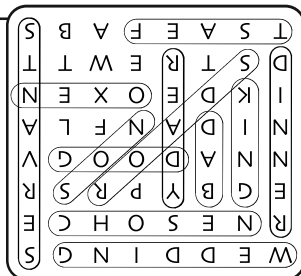

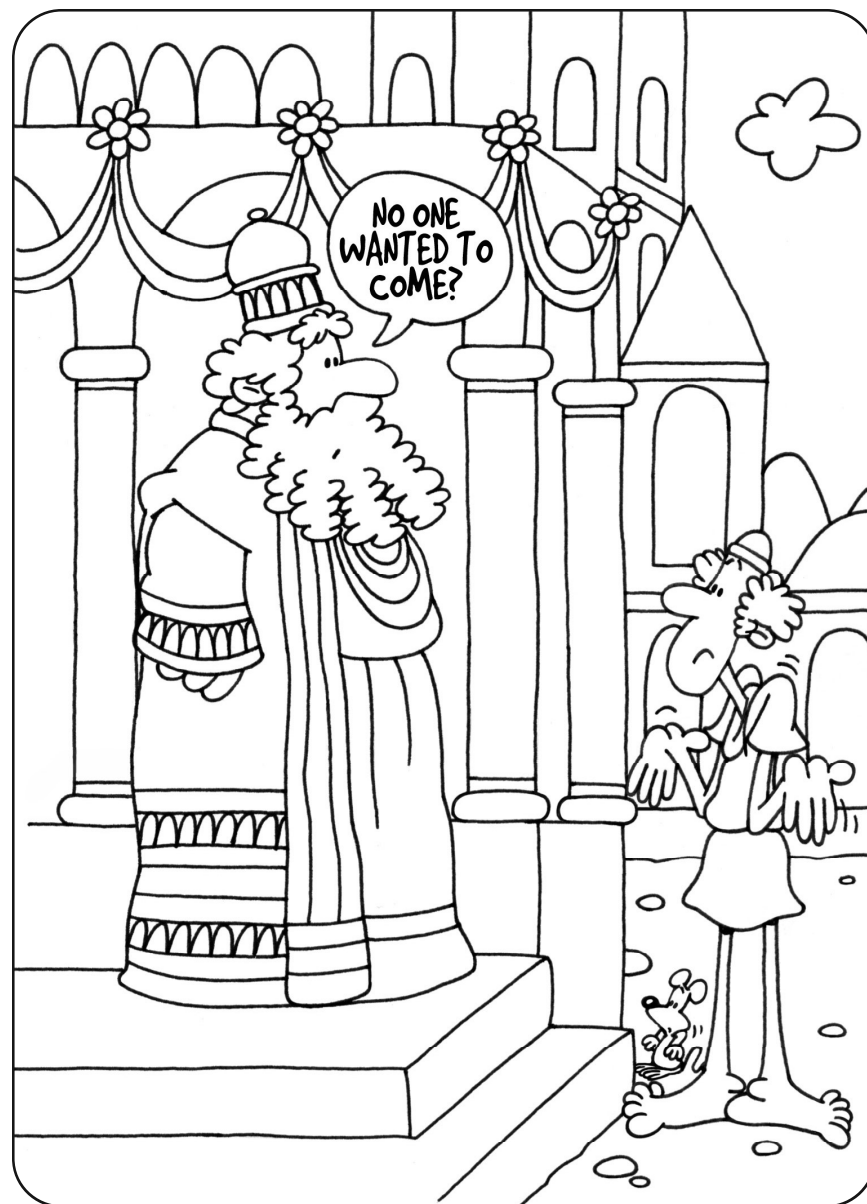

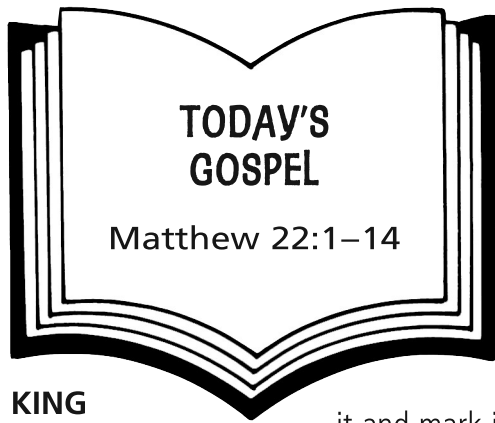
