Holy Communion at Zion


The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation as Jesus has given it. As he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. *All communicants* need to register in the narthex prior to the service.

Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, are asked not to commune until they are able to speak with our pastor first. He is happy to visit with you about the Christian faith and how to receive the Lord's Supper for your good and for the good of others. Those not communing are invited to come to the altar, cross your arms in front of you, and bow your head to receive a pastoral blessing.

<u>The Lord Jesus Comes in the Flesh to Fulfill the Law for Us</u> <u>and Save Us from Our Sins</u>

Circumcision is the covenant God made with Abraham and his seed. It sealed God's promises and blessings in the flesh, but it also signified the burden of the Law. When the Lord Jesus came in the flesh to redeem His people, He subjected Himself to the Law in order to fulfill the Law and release all men from its captivity. "He was called Jesus" (Luke 2:21), because He came to save His people from their sins. He would shed His blood on their behalf, as He did already when "he was circumcised" (Luke 2:21). As He also sacrificed Himself upon the cross, you are "justified by faith" in His blood (Gal. 3:24). Therefore, "you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise" (Gal. 3:29), not by the circumcision of your flesh, but in the flesh and blood of Christ Jesus, the true seed of Abraham. "Baptized into Christ," you belong to Him and are clothed and covered by His righteousness (Gal. 3:27). Holy Baptism is the true circumcision made without hands, by which the Lord Jesus puts His name on you and blesses you (Num. 6:22, 27).

Zach DeLoach Nicaragua Mission Trip: Dear brother's and sister's in Christ,

I wanted to take the time to thank God for each and every one of you for supporting me on the Nicaragua mission trip that I was just a part of. Your support and prayers have meant the world to me, and the trip did not disappoint!

The Nicaragua mission was full of the giving and receiving of Christ's word, and the love and hope that comes with that. The community of Masatepe welcomed us with open arms and treated us very well.

We were so blessed to meet so many incredible people, whose examples of faith are inspiring. There is one such example that I wish to share with you, as it greatly impacted me.

There is a community member in Masatepe whose name is Don Beto. The coffee shop we stayed at which provided good jobs and a place of bible study to the community, was named Beto's in honor of this man. He is now 76 years old, but for about 55 years, he has owned his own clothing production business, which is entirely employed now by rehabbing alcoholics. Beto works there, offering guidance and ministry to the workers and everyday, goes door to door in his community to pray for families and encourage them to attend the local church and, "have their sins forgiven." Beto encouraged all of us in a bonfire chat to, "never put God in a box." He explained to us that we are a good creation, that God made us for his purposes and plans. That we can have immense comfort in that we have such a loving creator who even when we fall away, sends His only Son to us on the cross to redeem us and show us that we are not in charge, but that He is and that He is good.

So this new year, I would simply like to thank you all for being God's creation, for reflecting his encouraging nature upon me, and for allowing me to go on the mission through. For we are called to spread the Gospel in everything we say and do. As Christ says in Acts 1:7 as he ascends into heaven: "He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Cool things that happened on the trip:

- 1. Many service projects where we got to renovate the coffee shop and pineapple farm.
- 2. My pal Val got baptised, and 20 seconds later it rained for 2 min and then stopped!
- 3. We prayed over struggling alcoholics in the community and then enjoyed a rousing game of soccer! (I was on defense)
- 4. All of the wisdom and grace shown to us and offered to us by the community! It was such an amazing group of people!
- 5. Disconnecting. It felt good to be walking with just the people you saw everyday and with God.
- 6. All of the food!!! Don't get me started!!!!
