Why Attend a Legacy Workshop?

Most people have loved ones they wish to remember in their estate plan. Most Lutherans also support ministries that are important to them, including their congregation. Yet few really know the best way to do everything they want to do for their loved ones and to make a gift for ministry. Rather they are educational, offering information about mistakes people often make in their estate plans (resulting in more in taxes and less to their loved ones). The seminar also provides information on several ways members can make reduced tax gifts for their loved ones and for ministry. You can leave your checkbook at home, as the presenter has nothing to sell. These workshops are offered as a free gift to attendees thanks to the support of the Nebraska District, LCMS; Concordia University, Nebraska and the LCMS Foundation.

If you do not have a will, if you have not created or reviewed your estate plan in the past 5 years, if you want to leave a gift for your congregation and other ministries, or if you just want ideas on how to reduce taxes and get more to your family and your favorite ministries, it is important that you attend this workshop!
