
Zion Lutheran School Foundation

A COMPARISON OF AVERAGES


ABOUT OUR TESTING


How does Zion Lutheran School compare to other schools academically? Zion uses the NWEA MAP assessment to gauge student learning. This test is given in fall, winter, and spring testing sessions and gives teachers, students, and families, immediate feedback on achievement. The MAP assessment has become the assessment of choice for the Lutheran schools of the Nebraska district and is also administered by Kearney Public Schools. This uniformity of testing allows us now to better compare school achievement using classroom averages. This document will illustrate how Zion compares with other Lutheran schools and students nationally.



* 1st/ 2nd graders are only assessed on math and reading.


** These scores represent a true average of high and low student scores;no scores are excluded. Soli Deo gloria! To God alone be the glory!
